TRAVEL EASILY WITH MAPS WITHOUT BARRIERS

Konto Bariéry – a project of Nadace Charty 77 (Foundation Charter 77) and its "Maps Without Barriers" makes planning trips and holidays easier for people with limited mobility.

People with disabilities who like to travel spend a long time before each trip finding out whether a monument has barrier-free access or what the car park is like. It is not just people with disabilities who have to deal with this kind of planning, however. Active senior citizens, families with prams and other groups of people with limited mobility also appreciate clear and easily available accessibility information.

The "Maps Without Barriers" project mapped the accessibility of almost 600 buildings in the Czech Republic in 2015. Experts verified the accessibility of cultural sites and other buildings of interest to tourists – they found out the widths of doors, the presence of access ramps and their inclines, the dimensions of lift cabins and toilet accessibility and facilities. The information they discovered is available from the "Maps Without Barriers" web app and thanks to the open-source licence, also in apps that users know

and use today.
